

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. If my child was born before 1 January 2025, but EDD was in January 2025, is he/she eligible for the SG60 Baby Gift?

Singapore Citizen (SC) children with Estimated Date of Delivery (EDD) on or after 1 January 2025 but were born before 1 January 2025 will be eligible for the SG60 Baby Gift.

Parents may register at <https://go.gov.sg/SG60BabyGift> with the relevant supporting documents uploaded:

- a) Your child's Birth Certificate, and
- b) A doctor's certification of your child's EDD.

Q2. If my child is born overseas and is a Singapore Citizen, is he/she eligible for the SG60 Baby Gift?

All Singapore Citizen (SC) children born in 2025 are eligible for the SG60 Baby Gift, including SC children born overseas. As only local delivery is available, parents based overseas can nominate a Singapore-based proxy to receive the Gift on their behalf.

Q3. Who can I contact if I have queries regarding the SG60 Baby Gift?

For queries regarding Gift registration or the community events, parents may contact SG60_Baby_Gift@pmo.gov.sg. Parents who have registered for the Gift and have queries regarding its delivery may contact our appointed vendor, Noel Gifts International Ltd, at SG60BabyGift@noel.com.sg.

Q4. When will home deliveries start?

Home deliveries will start from mid-May 2025. Upon successful registration, our appointed vendor will contact parents via SMS from May onwards to arrange for home delivery.
